Day 1: (2JUL): Sydney Intl. Airport / Taipei, Taiwan Depart with CI52 at 22:00

Day 2: (3JUL): Arrive Taiwan / Sun Moon Lake / Puli / Chiayi (L/D)

We will visit Nantou, where Sun Moon Lake is located. It is Taiwan's largest lake with the east side shaped like "Sun", and West side shaped like "Moon", hence the name "Sun Moon Lake". Sightseeing around the area includes: famous Wenwu Temple and Literature Warrior Temple dedicated to Confucius as Master of Pen and to Kuan Ti as Master of Sword, and Holy Monk Shrine. The Aboriginal Formosan Village will be visited. The 2010 Lantern Festival official host city is Chiayi, which is within walking distance to the hotel you will stay tonight. There is nightmarket nearby too.
Overnight: Maison De Chine Hotel, Chiayi

Day 3: (4JUL): Chiayi / Alishan / Kaohsiung (B/L)

After having buffet breakfast at hotel, you will depart for the "Eight Wonders of Taiwan - Alishan", which is located at the end of the Alishan Forest Railway. you will be transferred to Kaohsiung City, where will have the City Tour of Kaohsiung, see the largest industrial harbour- Kaohsiung Harbour in Taiwan, and the second busiest harbour in Asia. In the evening, you will visit "Liuho Night Market", to taste the Taiwanese deserts and snacks. You can then visit the famous "Love River" which is now renowned for its cafe culture and night tour which are popular among local couples for a romantic night.
Overnight: Garden Villa Hotel, Kaohsiung



Day 4: (5JUL): Kaohsiung / Kenting / Chihben, Taitung (B/L/D)

After breakfast, the tour will be departing for Kenting National Park. Other sightseeing will be visited today are the southernmost tip of Taiwan, Maopitou & Olunpai Light House. We then continue to Taitung via the Scenic Southern Link Highway. Overnight at Taitung and enjoy a relaxing hot spring bath at the 5 star hotel in Chiben area.
Overnight: Naruwan Hotel, Taitung

Day 5: (6JUL): Chihben / East Coast National Scenic Area / Hualien (B/L/D)

After Breakfast at the hotel, we will drive to "Tainan Aboriginal Beinan Cultural Village" it is the site where the BC civil human evidences have been found. Then we will drive thru the HuaTong Mt Route, where we will stop at: "Butterfly Valley" which is abundance with beautiful landscape and natural environment. It's just the perfect essence to a perfect relaxing vacation and well renowned butterfly sceneries. Here you can enjoy a unique natural experience and amazing comfortable sensation outdoor hot spring and spa in the deluxe Butterfly valley Resort. Tonight you will be overnight at Hualien City.
Overnight: Chateau De Chine Hotel, Hualien

Day 6: (7JUL): Hualien / Taroko Gorge / Yehliu / Taipei (B/L/D)

Taroko Gorge is an exceptionally beautiful area of Taiwan. It is the "Seven Wonder of Asia", its narrow raving created by the Liwu River which has cut deep into the mountains of solid marble. A road carved into sheer walls of rock rewinding its way past forested peaks and cliffs towering thousands of feet above it,



While hundreds of feet below a river roars past gigantic marble boulders. On our way back to Taipei, we will drive pass the "Chingshuei Cliff" located on the section of the Suao-Hualien Highway that stretches between Heping and Chongde stations, is one of the most spectacular sights on Taiwan's Pacific coast. The cliff is more than 1,000 meters high and drops almost vertically into the sea. The highway snakes along its curving face more than 20 kilometers, with the sheer cliff rising on one side and a sheer drop to the ocean on the other. We will then drive back to Taipei via Su-Hua Highway and Hsuei-Shan Long Tunnel (12.9 kilometers) to arrive Taipei in the evening.

Overnight: Howard Plaza Hotel, Taipei

Day 7: (8JUL): Taipei / Chiufen / Yeliu (B)

After breakfast, you will be taking to Wulai, it is famous for hot spring, waterfall, and Aboriginal culture. There is even a cable car to whisk you up to the top of the mountain to have panoramic view of the valley. The "Wulai Old Street" will be visited, where you can taste the many famous Taiwanese gourmet and snacks. After Lunch, we will depart for Yehliu Ocean Park. It is known for its spectacular rock formations, sculptured throughout the ages by wind and sea erosion leaving fascinating pillars, including the famous "Queen's Head" and "Fairy's Shoe". The next stop in the evening will be **Chiufen Village**, famous for its old mining town's charming characteristics. Many famous Taiwanese movies were shot here. You will be able to see the beautiful sunset when you arrive at the village. Dinner will be a great variety of choices at the village's traditional shops.

Overnight: Howard Plaza Hotel, Taipei

Day 8: (9JUL): Taipei / Yangmingshan National Park / Taipei City Sightseeing (B/L)

After breakfast, we will visit Yanmingshan National Park. Other sightseeings for today are: Presidential Building (Pass by), Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall and National Palace Museum (has the largest Chinese art and painting collection). Lunch will be held at the famous restaurant inside the museum where the chef was favored by the ex-President Chen. After lunch, we will visit Martyrs' Shrine. In the evening, you will be treated by the famous Taiwanese foot massage. Tonight you will visit the largest night market in Taiwan, "Shilin Night Market". In the night market, you will able to explore and see all sorts of bargains.
Overnight: Howard Plaza Hotel, Taipei

Day 9: (10JUL): Taipei / TPE Intl Airport (B)

After breakfast, you will have leisure time to explore the vibrant city of Taipei, a shopaholic's heaven. About 7PM you will be transferred to the Taipei International Airport for flight back to Australia at 23:55PM.

Day 10: (11JUL): Sydney, Australia (B)

Arrive Sydney Intl Airport at approx 12:15 AM.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation is based on twin or double-bedded rooms. Triple share accommodation will consist of two single beds plus a rollaway bed. The hotels listed in this brochure will be used on all departures. If a change should become necessary for any reason, the hotel substituted will be of an equivalent standard to those shown. Any hotel description is based upon advice received from the applicable hotel and whilst Taiwan Holidays & Travel will make every effort to ensure that all details are correct at the time of printing, Taiwan Holidays can take no responsibility for information used in good faith. Normal check-in time for hotels in Taiwan is 2pm and any arrival before this time may lead to a room not being readily available.

AIRFARES

There are a number of Domestic and International airfares that may be used with your holiday package. These airfares will have special conditions and will be subject to availability. No airline will incur responsibility to any person named in the booking aside from that liability as may be incurred by the carrier.

RESERVATION & DEPOSITS

A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person (for air and land package) or \$100 per person (for land only booking) must be received by Taiwan Holidays & Travel within 7 days of confirmation or your reservation. You will be notified at the time of your reservation if any additional deposit requirements apply.

FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment is due no later than 30 days before departure from Australia. For bookings made within 30 days of departure from Australia, deposit is due within 24 hours and balance / final payment within 7 days. Any booking not paid for at the designated time may incur a late payment fee of \$2 per day. If, for any reason, this final payment is not received by Taiwan Holidays & Travel by the due date, Taiwan Holidays & Travel reserves the right to treat your booking as cancelled and apply appropriate cancellation charges. Payments by credit card will incur a surcharge of merchant fees.

AMENDMENTS

Any amendment to your holiday may incur fees. An amendment is considered to be a change to your booking where the booking value does not increase. Where a client requests a change of hotel, departure, type of room, or tour, an amendment fee of \$20 per change per booking will apply up to 30 days prior departure (if travel documents have not been issued). Amendments made after documentation has been issued will incur a reissue fee of \$100 plus any airline or supplier reissue fees. A transfer to an alternative tour is considered a cancellation and subsequent fees will be applied.

LATE BOOKINGS

Any reservation made within 7 days prior to departure will incur a non-refundable Late Booking fee of \$20 per booking (for air and land package), or \$10 Late Booking Fee (for land only) whether the reservation can be confirmed or not. Full payment for your holiday together with the applicable Late Booking fee must be received by Taiwan Holidays & Travel within 48 hours of booking. No reservations will be processed until the applicable payment has been received by Taiwan Holidays & Travel. Failure to comply with these terms will result in the automatic cancellation of the reservations request.

CANCELLATIONS

Should you wish to cancel or terminate any reservation made, there will be no refund of your Deposit, and we will charge a Cancellation Fees. Bookings cancelled within 14 days of departure and after departure will be non-refundable. Bookings cancelled more than 15 days prior departure will incur cancellation fees of minimum \$800 per person.

CANCELLATIONS BY US

The Department of Health or your preferred medical practitioner will be able to advise with the current requirements and recommendation.

LUGGAGE

We recommend that you only pack and bring with your luggage that you can safely handle yourself if required. Whilst porters are available at larger hotels, coach parking areas at some airports or train stations may be some distance. The airline regulation baggage allowance for travel in Economy class is 20Kgs and is often strictly adhered to. Please ensure that you make every effort to comply with this restriction. Cabin baggage should not exceed 5Kgs and there are restrictions on the carriage of liquids or any kind inside aircraft. Please refer to the applicable airline or check with your travel agent or Taiwan Holidays & Travel consultant for details.

RESPONSIBILITY
